

CEDAR RAPIDS USBC BA SCHOLARSHIP FUND

INSTRUCTIONS AND APPLICATION FORMS

THE CEDAR RAPIDS USBC BA HAS ESTABLISHED A SCHOLARSHIP FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING MONETARY ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS TO ELIGIBLE CEDAR RAPIDS AREA USBC YOUTH AND/OR COLLEGIATE MEMBERS WHO WISH TO CONTINUE THEIR EDUCATION BEYOND THE HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL.

ARTICLE I PURPOSE

- a) To promote continuing education of our youth at an accredited technical school or college/university.
- b) To help develop in youth, the ideals of good citizenship and sportsmanship.
- c) Provide scholarship funds for qualified Youth bowlers who have chosen to continue their education.

ARTICLE II ELIGIBILITY

- a) Must have been a sanctioned youth bowler, sanctioned high school bowler, sanctioned collegiate bowler, or a combination for at least three (3) bowling seasons (includes current season membership).
- b) Have participated in one of the above activities within the jurisdiction of the Cedar Rapids USBC BA.

ARTICLE III APPLICATION

- a) Applicants must submit written application each year by March 1st. Any application not postmarked by this date will not be accepted for consideration that calendar year.
- b) Application forms may be obtained at all bowling centers within the jurisdiction of the Cedar Rapids USBC BA or may be found on the Cedar Rapids USBC BA web page at www.cedarrapidsbowling.com.
- c) A reminder will be sent to all USBC Youth bowlers who have reached the age of 16 by August 1st of the current bowling season and that are currently members of the Cedar Rapids Area USBC Youth Association. This reminder will also be sent to all high school coaches in the Cedar Rapids USBC BA jurisdiction.

ARTICLE IV SCHOLARSHIP LIMITATIONS / AWARDS

- a) Scholarships will be awarded each year to selected applicants by the Cedar Rapids USBC BA as determined by the Scholarship committee with the number and dollar amount approved by the Board of Directors.
- b) Applicants not selected may reapply for consideration the following year and/or each succeeding year as their eligibility is maintained. Applicants may not apply after completion of their junior year of college.
- c) Scholarships will be awarded no later than May 31st of each year. Said scholarship funds will be deposited with the USBC Smart Program and all disbursements will be made per the Smart Program. Scholarship awards will not be made payable directly to the individual.



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APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- a) Fill out form Scholarship 01 entirely.
- b) Write an essay of no less than 200 words on the following topics:
 1. What bowling means or has done for you.
 2. What are your plans for bowling in the future?
 3. Why I should receive this scholarship.
 4. Include any comments or pertinent information you think may help explain your situation and help the committee evaluate your application.
- c) Give your coach form Scholarship 02. Ask your coach to complete the evaluation and return to you by Feb 15th.
- d) To have your application considered by the scholarship committee, it must include the following items:
 - Completed application with applicant **and** parent/guardian signature
 - Coaches' completed evaluation
 - Completed essay
